Wednesday 11th to Monday 23rd August, 2021— 13 Days / 12 Nights

Enjoy views of the rugged coastline above Port Douglas from the decks of an original Chinese Junk sailing vessel as you anticipate your immersion in the jungles, rivers, reefs and beaches of the Wet Tropics and beyond. Cruise along the Daintree River through the World Heritage listed rainforest, the earth's oldest at 180 million years old. See the smile of a crocodile and learn about the tropical environment and the mangrove eco-system. Traverse the splendidly scenic 4wd Bloomfield Track, popping into the iconic Lions Den Hotel on the way to Cooktown, where the many layers of Australia's history will unfold. Take a 1500km return flight above Cape York Peninsula and the Great Barrier Reef, landing on idyllic islands of the Torres Strait all viewed on the world's longest scenic flight. In Quinkan country interpret rock art paintings with renowned and knowledgeable Nugal-warra elder, Willie Gordon on his ancestral lands. The Atherton Tablelands

hosts ancient crater lakes, gigantic trees, wondrous waterfalls and an abundance of birdlife and unique wildlife observed from your rainforest accommodation and from above on the Mamu Rainforest Canopy Skywalk. Explore the enchanting Paronella Park and the Undara lava tubes. Roam picturesque Dunk and Beddara Islands and snorkel or scuba dive the outer Great Barrier Reef. Taste delights on paddock to plate experiences, visit coffee, tea and cocoa plantations. Ride on the Savannahlander train and ramble around historic Herberton and also Chillagoe with its pretty limestone caves and marble mines. End your expedition with your fellow adventurers in Cairns with fine dining in its newest hotel with the best views and most luxurious suites on offer !


